

Storage of personal data obtained from video surveillance of the Monheim am Rhein jetty

1 Scope

1.1 The City of Monheim am Rhein makes the following jetty available to operators of passenger ships for temporary docking and mooring:

Schiffsanleger (jetty) of the City of Monheim am Rhein Rhine kilometer 713.858 on the right river bank (located within the city limits of Monheim)

- 1.2 CCTV cameras are installed around the jetty, which are operated by Stadtentwicklungsgesellschaft Monheim am Rhein mbH (SEG), a subsidiary of the City of Monheim am Rhein.
- 1.3 As the owner of the property, Stadtentwicklungsgesellschaft Monheim am Rhein mbH (SEG) is the controller of the data obtained from the video surveillance of the Monheim jetty in accordance with Article 13 GDPR.

2 Information on the rights of data subjects

- 2.1 The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation from the data controller as to whether or not their personal data is being processed, and, where that is the case, the data subject has the **right to obtain information** on this personal data and the information specifically mentioned in Article 15 GDPR.
- 2.2 The data subject has the right to demand from the controller the immediate **rectification** of incorrect personal data concerning the subject and completion of incomplete personal data (Article 16 GDPR).
- 2.3 The data subject has the right to demand from the controller the immediate erasure of their personal data if any of the reasons detailed in Article 17 GDPR apply, e.g., when the data is no longer required for its intended purpose (right to erasure).
- 2.4 The data subject has the right to demand the **restriction of the processing** of their personal data from the controller if one of the reasons listed in Article 18 GDPR applies, e.g., should the data subject have objected to the processing, the controller shall restrict the processing of said data for the time it takes the controller to verify the objection.

- 2.5 The data subject hast the right to **object** to the processing of their personal data on grounds relating to their personal situation at any time. In this event, the controller may no longer process the data unless the controller can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the data subject's interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims (Article 21 GDPR).
- 2.6 Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, every data subject has the right to **lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority** if the data subject considers the processing of their personal data to infringe upon the provisions of the GPPR (Article 77 GDPR). The data subject may exercise this right by lodging a complaint with the competent supervisory body in the member state of their place of residence, place of work, or in the place of the alleged infringement.
